for people approaching their final days and all who care for them







## From the Diocese . . .

**Quinquennial Inspection Grant Update** 

Don't forget that your church's Quinquennial Inspection is due every 5 years. The Diocese now offers increased grant funding of  $\pounds650$  to parishes, as a contribution towards the cost. This is no longer linked to payment of parish share, and will be paid directly to the parish.

**New Parish Treasurer Support Service** 

If you're struggling to find a Parish Treasurer, the Diocese can now offer a book keeping service to ensure that parishes can still fulfil their statutory obligations by producing annual accounts and regular reports for PCC meetings. As part of this, we can also work with the parish to provide Gift Aid Claims and applications for VAT reclaims through the listed places of worship grant scheme. We can also help parishes work out a budget.
